LOCATED AT THE HEART OF COMMERCE, CULTURE AND INNOVATION

Sydney is Australia's commercial powerhouse and the gateway to its distinguished research, scientific and technology sectors with ICC Sydney located at the heart of these communities. Over 600 multinational companies run their Asia Pacific operations from Sydney and 45% of the top 500 companies in Australasia are located in New South Wales.

ICC Sydney's waterfront location in Darling Harbour attracts more than 26 million people annually. Set amongst green spaces, restaurants, retail and a vibrant public domain, ICC Sydney is only a 10-minute walk to Australia's largest city centre as well as surrounding university, cultural, creative and technology quarters.





ICC SYDNEY EXHIBITION FACILITIES

VENUE LAYOUT AND DESIGN

ICC Sydney is a totally integrated venue, offering ease of access across the venue via an internal concourse, which is linked to a number of major access points. Natural light floods foyers and pre function spaces through glass facades offering spectacular views of Sydney.

The Exhibition Centre consists of seven halls totalling 32,600sqm across two levels with a further 2,400sqm of boutique, multipurpose space called The Gallery, located on level two of the Convention Centre.



WORLD CLASS TECHNOLOGY

ICC Sydney offers leading technological solutions to clients, exhibitors and attendees including venue wide access to high bandwidth, high density and robust wireless connectivity, dynamic and interactive digital signage and elite conferencing facilities.

In response to the 'bring your own device' trend, ICC Sydney has installed easy to use 'intelligent lecterns' which allow several devices to connect at once, either through physical ports or via the integrated Wi-Fi for presentations.

FLOOR LOADING AND SERVICE PITS

Floor loading capacity across both levels is 20kPa. Service pits are based on a 6m x 6m grid, with trenches allowing safe and efficient reticulation of additional services as required. Services include in-ground access to 3 phase power, data, water and drainage. Compressed air can be provided.

LOADING DOCKS

The level 1 loading dock servicing halls 1-4 is undercover and located internally on the eastern side of the venue. Each hall has a 5.6m wide x 4.5m high loading dock door.

The level 4 loading dock servicing halls 5-7 is located at the western side of the venue, accessed from Darling Drive, with a separate one way circulation system. Each hall has a 6m wide x 4.5m high loading dock door.

THE GALLERY

The Gallery has floor service boxes on a $6m \times 9m$ grid with additional wall service boxes. Each floor service box has 1 x 3 phase 32 amp power, 2 x single phase power and 2 x data outlets. Floor loading at this level is 5kPa. Loading dock facilities are also available for The Gallery via the Convention Centre.

GREEN TRANSPORT & ACCESS OPTIONS

It is now even easier for you and your clients/guests to get to the exhibition with ICC Sydney's multiple public access points - the venue can be reached by foot, car, coach and light rail.



Airport

Darling Harbour is only 8km from Sydney Airport.



Bus

ICC Sydney has its own bus stop. Bus routes 389 and 501 stop at Harris Street near Allen Street - a 10-minute walk from ICC Sydney.



Ferry

Cruise into Darling Harbour on a ferry with direct services from Circular Quay, King Street Wharf or Pyrmont Bay Wharf.



Parking

ICC Sydney has two car park facilities located within the Exhibition Centre and First State Super Theatre, comprising a total of 826 car spaces. Additionally, there are a number of secure car parks located in and around Darling Harbour, the closest located at Harbourside Car Park, 100 Murray Street, Pyrmont.



Sydney Light Rail

The Light Rail travels right through a number of Darling Harbour stations including ICC Sydney's Convention Centre and Exhibition Centre stops. The Light Rail starts at Central Station in the CBD and travels to Dulwich Hill in the inner west.



Taxi

The best taxi drop off and pick up locations include the new Iron Wharf Place next to Harbourside Shopping Centre and Zollner Circuit on the Southern end of First State Super Theatre, both accessed via Darling Drive.



A short walk from Central or Town Hall will take you directly to Darling Quarter, Tumbalong Park and Sydney Visitor Centre. Town Hall and Central Stations are a 10-minute walk from ICC Sydney.



Water Taxi

A water taxi is a great option for getting to and from Darling Harbour. Water Taxi's depart from The Rocks, Circular Quay, The Opera House and Luna Park.

GENERAL AMENITIES

Visitors to ICC Sydney will have access to a range of banking facilities with numerous ATMs located throughout the venue. The Commonwealth Bank of Australia is conveniently located on the eastern side of Tumbalong Park, directly opposite the Exhibition Centre.

Mobile service charge stations, prayer rooms, luxury concierge, VIP meeting rooms, hospitality lounges and onsite cloak room facilities form part of ICC Sydney's suite of amenities available for visitor convenience across the venue.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE


