MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS (Please tick to indicate that you have read and understood.)

Food or beverage samples must be directly related to the exhibitor's core business either demonstrating a food product or equipment.

Sample food portions must be served as bite-sized pieces or in maximum 50g portions.

If you are intending to sample beverages, pours are limited to:

- non-alcoholic beverage (100ml or less)
- liquor spirit (20ml or less)
- wine and beer (50ml or less).

All persons serving alcohol samples must hold a current NSW Responsible Service of Alcohol competency card, a copy of which must be supplied to the event organiser and ICC Sydney prior to and upon request during tenancy.

Mandatory Liquor and Gaming NSW signage is to be clearly displayed on each stand serving alcohol along with free water (<u>www.liquorandgaming.nsw.gov.au</u>).

Temporary food stalls need to practice safe food handling and preparation to meet the same food safety requirement as other NSW retail food businesses.

This includes:

- notifying the local council of their business and food activity details
- meeting the requirements of the Food Standards Code

Details of the ingredients in food and beverage products are to be available including the presence of any allergens.

City of Sydney safety regulations that cover all distribution of food and beverage products apply to all events held at ICC Sydney.

Businesses may be required to register for a Temporary Foodstall Permit (TFP) with the City of Sydney Council. Please include TFP or reference number provided by the council with your ICC Sydney application. Please visit the council website for further information <u>Register a</u> <u>temporary food stall - City of Sydney (nsw.gov.au)</u>

NOTICE: ICC Sydney holds the exclusive liquor licence and is the sole seller of alcohol at the venue. **Third-party sales for on-site consumption or take-away are strictly prohibited**. While orders may be placed for future fulfillment, consumption on-site is not permitted. ICC Sydney reserves the right to enforce its rights for any breach of this condition.

NOTE: per Food Standards ANZ appendix 9:

A 'food business' operation includes the handling of food for sale or the sale of any food, even if it occurs only once.

'Sale' includes any gain to the business from providing the food, not just the direct exchange of money for food.
